

Kia ora koutou,

We're halfway through the year, and I would like to take this opportunity to re-establish the guidelines around Home Learning.

It is expected that your child reads for at least 20 minutes per day and records this in their Do it Diary. This is the only written expectation for the students.

Your child's spelling words are available on their teacher's Spelling City website. You are more than welcome to support your child by testing them and checking in with them. Anything less than 10/12 per week consistently either means the home learning is not being completed, or the words are being set too high. Please talk to your child's teacher about this.

It is a school expectation that your child achieves 1000 points in Mathletics per week (Monday-Monday). This is tracked by the teachers. I have noticed across the team that there are a significant number of students that are not completing this. They have access to Mathletics before school, and there is a 'computer time' allocated to each Maths group each week. If you have any issues with logging in, please email me so I can resolve the issues.
